ORDINANCE 2021-XXXX

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 FOR EACH FUND OF THE CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE V, SECTION 5 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY, BEGINNING JULY 1, 2021, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2022, APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNTS SHOWN IN EACH BUDGET AS EXPENDITURES, ADOPTING THE ITEM OF ANTICIPATED FUNDING SOURCES, PROHIBITING EXPENDITURES TO EXCEED APPROPRIATIONS, AND PROHIBITING EXPENDITURES FROM EXCEEDING ACTUAL FUNDING SOURCES

- **WHEREAS,** a proposed budget for each of the various funds of the City has been presented to the Mayor and City Council; and
- **WHEREAS,** appropriate advertised public hearings have been held on the proposed budget, as required by law and regulations; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget, and the Budget Message pursuant to Section 3-1-3 of the City Code, have been filed in the office of the City Clerk and open for public inspection; and
- WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have reviewed the proposed budget; and
- **WHEREAS,** each of the funds has a balanced budget, such that anticipated funding sources equal or exceed proposed expenditures; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Mayor and City Council intend to adopt an annual budget for the Fiscal Year 2022:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Morrow, pursuant to their authority, as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Morrow, Georgia hereby adopts a budget for the Fiscal Year 2022, said budget being described below;

Section 2. That any increase or decrease in appropriations or revenue of any fund or for any department; the establishment of new capital projects; or the establishment of new grant projects other than those exceptions provided for herein, shall require approval of the City Council; and

Section 3. That this budget establishes a COLA increase of 2.6% to all eligible employees effective January 1, 2022 if they meet certain standards; and

Section 4. That this budget fixes the number of established Morrow full-time equivalent positions at 88.5. This number may only be increased or decreased through approval of the Mayor and City Council; and

Section 5. That the City Manager and his/her designee may promulgate all necessary internal rules, regulations, and policies to ensure that this Budget Ordinance is followed.
