This proposed budget for 2011-2012 was presented to the Harris County Board of Education on May 24, 2011 for tentative approval. It will be reviewed again on June 2, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. at which time the Board and the Superintendent will conduct a public forum for any interested parties to present any additional input or comments. The Board and the Superintendent will take input under advisement. The FY 12 budget will be considered for final adoption at the regular Board meeting which will be held on June 14, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. The FY 2012 proposed budget is based on an estimated 17.41 mills for maintenance and operations in the general fund and is also based on using \$933,496.00 of the beginning fund equity balance in the general fund (anticipated at approximately \$4,200,000.00) to hold down taxes. The bond millage rate is estimated to be .65 mills This proposed budget also anticipates that one-half of the debt service payment on one bond series for FY 12 (\$654,717.00) and the full payment on two bond series (\$1,081,099.00) will be paid from SPLOST revenue. Both of these estimated millage rates are based on input received from county officials. The total estimated millage for FY 2012 (18.06), therefore, is a one (I) mill M&O increase over the millage rate for FY 2012.

Both of the June meetings (June 2, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. and June 14, 2011 at 6:30 p.m.) will be held in the auditorium of the Central Office of the Harris County School System located on Barnes Mill Road in Hamilton. The public is welcome to attend either or both of these meetings.
